Pasado's Safe Haven believes Girl Scout badges are a great way for girls to explore their interests while learning about animals. These programs can be completed at your troop's location or at our sanctuary where the girls will have the opportunity to meet our rescued animals.

Daisies "Three Cheers for Animals"

Girls learn about different animals, how caring for animals links with caring for themselves and each other, and talk about how they can educate the community about respecting animals.

LEARN – Birdbath Award – Daisies learn to care for animals and for themselves

SEE – Red Robin Award – Daisies use their new knowledge and creativity to teach others how to care for animals

DO – Tula Award – Daisies gain courage and confidence in teaching others about animals



Brownies "Pets Badge"

Girls will learn that pets have many of the same needs that we do. Come see what it takes to care for a dog or cat (or even pigs and goats) and how to keep them happy, healthy, and safe. Through discussion and an interactive lesson plan girls will gain a better understanding of the responsibility and commitment it takes to have a pet.



Juniors "Animal Habitats Badge"

Girls will learn about the homes or habitats of farmed animals, what they need to be happy, and how we can help them. Through discussion and an interactive lesson plan girls will be able to grow in their understanding and compassion for animals, beyond the usual household pets.



Cadettes "Animal Helper Badge"

Girls explore the connection between humans and animals through an interactive presentation and discussion. With this lesson, girls will learn about the many ways that animals help us and the ways that we can help them in return.
