Sometimes companies that sell things like soap, shampoo, and makeup hurt animals through animal testing. Animal testing is when animals, like bunnies, are used to test soap, cleaning supplies, and makeup before they are sold. These tests are cruel to the animals and unnecessary with modern improvements in testing.

Understand community need and purpose of project.

After taking assessment of their own products, have Scouts consider what are the most popular cosmetic/hygiene products people in their community likely use.

Plan and prepare.

Have Scouts discuss what they want to teach their community – how to identify cruelty-free products, a cruelty-free shopping guide, the “why” behind choosing cruelty-free, etc.

From there, Scouts select the best way to message that topic.

Instruct Scouts to consider materials needed for their project, the audience they want to target, and a rough timeline.
