Adoption is a very important part of sanctuary work. Prompt Scouts to consider why adoption is so important to rescue. Some things to consider:

- Pasado's Safe Haven rescues domestic animals, who all need people in their lives to be happy and healthy. The farmed animals included!
- Adopting can influence others to do the same. You can also help teach people about the positives of a rescue pet (you know their personality, they are very loving, you get to show them new things).
- Adopting rescued animals helps to free up space at a shelter or sanctuary, meaning more animals can be rescued.
